There will be 3 distinct OPENS:

OPEN A reserved for players with ELO FSI / FIDE ≥ 1600 - 9 game rounds Swiss system, reflection time 90' for 40 moves + 30' to finish the game + 30" per player move.

OPEN B reserved for players with ELO FSI / FIDE up to 1799 - 9 game rounds Swiss system, reflection time 90' + 30" per player move.

OPEN C reserved for players with ELO FSI / FIDE < 1600 - 9 game rounds in the Swiss system, reflection time 90' + 30" one move per player.

Pre-registration via VeSuS.org by June 7, 2019.

Participation fee for pre-registered players:

OPEN A € 60.00 per player (free registration for GM, IM and FM)

OPEN B and C € 50.00 per player

Reduction of € 15.00 for women and Under 16, surcharge of € 10.00 for non-pre-registered players

Historical memory of the Sicilian chess has finally left us an important contribution through Scacchi & Scacchi, a monthly magazine of history, stories and chess curiosities, and of course Flash, a weekly magazine of chess information.

His biggest contribution is still this same festival, his creature, which for 22 editions has seen it in the foreground and that, now, tries to continue in his memory.
