Tournament conditions / Rules of the

7 rounds group A and 9 rounds group B Swiss system, girls and boys play in one tournament. The tournament will be held in the following age groups: Group A - open youth tournament up to U18, Group B - participants younger than U12 can take part in group B with an ELO> 1200 (ELO limit 1300) as well, restricted for participants with an ELO up to 1200 or up to U12 respectively. A participant with an ELO <1200 can of course play in group A. FIDE rules apply. ELO rating: Group A national & international, group B national. Time limit: group A 90 minutes (+30 sec/ move), group B 60 minutes – no draw offer before the 30th move – no contumacy time. All players (especially foreign guests) must have a FIDE-ID before the tournament starts, otherwise they are not eligible to play.

Conditions of participation

The tournament is open for all youths, domestic and abroad. Cutoff date for all age groups is always January 1st.
