Historical trace search through Fürstenfeld, the capital of the thermal spa region.

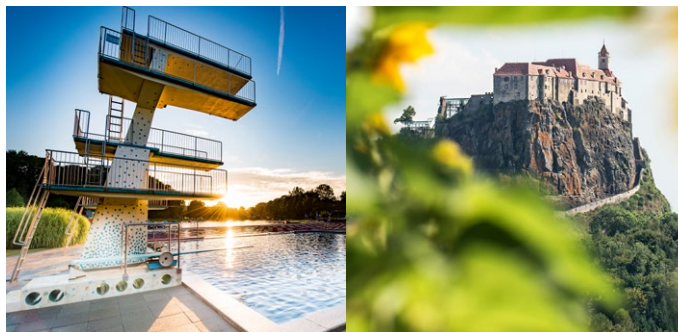


### Riegersburg Castle and birds of prey show / climbing park

## Leading Role in Youth Chess



After a period of 76 years the Chess Club Fürstenfeld looks back on a long tradition and a large number of successes in the game of kings. Especially the last years under chairman Siegfried Posch and his team of committed officials and coaches saw the successful development of young talents which finds great acclaim all over Austria and which serves as a role model for the promotion of young talents.

This exemplary dedication in the fields of club sports and the royal game is mirrored by top positions in various competitions. Last year, for example, we were able to celebrate two Austrian champions, Julian Leitgeb in the U16 and FIDE-champion Nico Marakovits in the U18. Additionally, youth U8 and U14 club players participated in the championship of the second class, and furthermore, the club took part in all six championships from the second class up to the Austrian national league.

The Chess Club Fürstenfeld also stood particularly out as event organiser – even on an international scale as the youth championships could be brought to the capital of the Styrian spa region in three categories from U8 up to U18. This year a young field of participants from all over Europe and beyond can be expected at the 7th International Raiffeisen Youth Chess Tournament after a record number of participants in 2023 with 122 chess talents from 11 nations.

At this year's event the young generation of players and their families are offered an awesome framework programme which goes way beyond our beloved mind sport and so the Chess Club Fürstenfeld also serves as a multiplying factor regarding the number of visitors of our town. I offer my gratitude and thanks to Siegfried Posch and his team for the organisation of this unique tournament and wish a very successful event.

## Tournament conditions / Rules of the game

7 rounds group A and 9 rounds groups B+C Swiss system, girls and boys play in one tournament. The tournament will be held in the following age groups: Group A - open youth tournament up to U18, Groups B+C - participants younger than U12 can take part in group B with an ELO > 1200 (ELO limit 1300) as well, restricted for participants with an ELO up to 1200 or up to U12 respectively. Group C limited up to ELO 900. A participant with an ELO <1200 can of course play in group A. FIDE rules apply. ELO rating: Group A national & international, groups B+C national. Time limit: group A 90 minutes (+30 sec/move), groups B+C 40 minutes (+30 sec/move) – no draw offer before the 30<sup>th</sup> move – no contumacy time. Groups B and C are registered for DWZ rating. All players (especially foreign guests) must have a **FIDE-ID** before the tournament starts, otherwise they are not eligible to play.

## Conditions of participation

The tournament is open for all youths, Austrian and international. Cutoff date for all age groups is always January 1<sup>st</sup>.
