# **ORGANIZERS:**

# **VENUE:**

The tournament is taking place in Moscow Hall in Grand Hotel Plovdiv\*\*\*\*.

# **TOURNAMENT SYSTEM:**

The championship will be played over Swiss system in 9 rounds.

#### **ORGANIZATION CONTRIBUTION:**

The board of directors of the Lokomotiv Sports Chess Club – Plovdiv, the main organizer of the international chess tournament Memorial "Georgi Tringov", informs that in order to provide part of the prize fund and expenses for the organization, every player wishing to participate in the tournament needs to pay 40 EUR.

The grandmasters are free of entry fee.

#### **PAIRINGS:**

Swiss-Manager, FIDE approved pairing software, will be used.

A player may take a ''half point bye'' only during the first round. He must request that to the chief arbiter before the pairings.

### **RATE OF PLAY:**

90 min. per player per game with increment of 30 sec. per move, starting from move 1.

#### **CHESS CLOCKS:**

Electronic DGT chess clocks will be used.

#### **VALIDITY:**

The championship is valid for FIDE and Bulgarian ratings and titles.

The tie-breaks are calculated using the parameters introduced in the "Swiss-Manager" software.
