Two tournaments: A-tournament: TWZ ≥ 1800 (at the time of registration), B-tournament: TWZ<2000 (at the start of the

tournament). No exceptions. Registered players for the B-tournament who exceed TWZ 1800 between registration and tournament start may

participate in the A-tournament for 10€ extra.

Both tournaments will be rated according to DWZ and ELO.
