# 2. SYSTEM AND RATE OF PLAY

- 2.1 Time Control:
  - Open A Playing time: 90 minutes for 40 moves plus 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.

- Open B, Open C, Open D, Open E, U10, U8 B&G - 90 minutes plus 30 seconds per move. 2.2 Festival tournaments system: 9 rounds played in the Swiss system.

  - 4. The greater number of victories;
  - 5. Progressive score.

4.3 In age tournaments: best results U7 and U9 girls and boys will be awarded cups and diplomas.
