REGULATIONS

I. Rapid chess tournament:

FIDE rapid chess rules apply.

| System: | Swiss system in 11 rounds with game control 15 minutes + 10 seconds per move for each player until the end of the game. |

| Starting rank: | 1. FIDE rating (rapid) / 2. FIDE rating (standard) / 3. Alphabetical order |
| Entry fee: | 50 BGN. For students up to 18 years old, seniors over 60 years old and members of the club, the fee is 30 BGN. GMs, WGMs and officially invited players are exempt from the fee. GM with raiting 2650+ and WGM with raiting 2450+ are accommodated free of charge, at the expense of the organizer. |

II. Blitz tournament

FIDE blitz chess rules apply. Participation in the blitz tournament is not tied to participation in the main rapid chess tournament.

REGISTRATION

Requests for registration in the tournament should be send in advance to **office@shumenchessclub.bg**, the deadline is **21.07.2024**, **Sunday**. It is desirable that the registration form contains the following information: title, first name, last name, FIDE ID, club(city), national federation

Bulgarian players without a FIDE ID should submit their first name, surname, last name, day of birth (dd.mm.yyyy), club(city). Before applying, foreign players without FIDE ID must register in the FIDE rating system by contacting their national FIDE rating administrator.

Players who do not meet the specified deadline pay a double fee.
