Tyrolean Chess Individual Championships 2025

The board of the Tyrol State Association has again decided to integrate the Tyrolean Individual Championships 2025 into the OPEN A as part of the second Chess Open in Innsbruck.

All players who are registered with a Tyrolean club and have their main residence in Tyrol are eligible to take part in the Tyrolean Individual Championship, regardless of nationality. For students who are registered with a Tyrolean club, a second residence is also sufficient. The participation criteria for the Open A must be met.

Prize fund for the Tyrolean Individual Championships open class (in addition to the Open A prize pool):

> 1st place € 350.00 2nd place € 250.00 3rd place € 150.00

The best-placed Tyrolean player receives the title "Tyrolean Chess Master 2025".

Prize fund for the Tyrolean women's individual championships (in addition to the Open A prize pool):

1st place € 100.00 2nd place € 75.00

The best-placed Tyrolean player receives the title of "Tyrolean Chess Champion 2025".

Titles and prizes will be awarded to a minimum of three players.



Tournaments

A - Open for players with an Elo rating of 1800 or more

B - Open for players with an Elo rating of 1500 - 1999

C - Open for players with an Elo rating of 0 - 1699

Nine rounds are played according to the Swiss system. The contumacy time is 30 minutes.

Second ranking in case of the same number of points:

- 1. FIDE Buchholz Cut-1 2. FIDE Buchholz total
- 3. ARO (Average Elo rating of opponents)

The prize money for the absolute prizes is distributed according to the Hort system. In the event of a tie, the following applies: For players with the same number of points, cash prizes are awarded half according to the rating and half divided.

Even if more players have the same number of points: Exactly 10 absolute prizes will be awarded in the A-Open, 5 absolute prizes in the B-Open and 3 absolute prizes in the C-Open.

In all three groups, a "half-point bye" (= draw without a draw) is possible from rounds 1-5 (can be requested in writing up until the end of the previous round or, if for the first round, before the start of the tournament and only possible if the entry fee has been paid).

Time control

A + B + C: 90 min + 30 min after 40 moves + 30 sec/move

Rating

The tournament will be submitted in all groups for international Elo rating, as well as for Austrian and German national Elo rating.
