#### 1. FESTIVAL EVENTS

- 1.1 Open A (participants: ELO higher than 1901 and Fide title Players)
- 1.2 Open B (participants: ELO lower than 2000, also unrated players)
- 1.3 Open C (participants: ELO lower than 1800, also unrated players)
- 1.4 Open D (participants: ELO lower than 1600, also unrated players)
- 1.5 Open E (participants: Only unrated players)
- 1.6 1st Open Blitz
- 1.7 2nd Open Blitz
- 1.8 Boys under 10 (Date of birth 2015 and after)
- 1.9 Girls under 10 (Date of birth 2015 and after)
- 1.10 Boys under 8 (Date of birth 2017 and after)
- 1.11 Girls under 8 (Date of birth 2017 and after)

#### 2. SYSTEM AND RATE OF PLAY

- 2.1 Time Control:
  - **Open A** - Playing time: 90 minutes for 40 moves plus 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.
  - **Open B, Open C, Open D, Open E, U10, U8 B&G** - 90 minutes plus 30 seconds per move.
- 2.2 Festival tournaments system: 9 rounds played in the Swiss system.

#### 4. TIE-BREAK SYSTEM AND TROPHIES

4.1 In case of equal points the order of players will be determined by the following tie-break procedures:

1. Buchholz cut-1, the highest number wins;
2. Buchholz, the highest number wins;
3. Direct Encounter;
4. The greater number of victories;
5. Progressive score.

4.2 Each tournament winners will be awarded Cups, Medals, Diplomas and money prizes.

4.3 In age tournaments: best results U7 and U9 girls and boys will be awarded cups and diplomas.
