1. Purpose of the tournament:

The V "Yuliyen Radulski Memorial" is being held after a several-year hiatus, caused by the pandemic situation and other factors that affected the development of Bulgarian chess.

The tournament is dedicated to Yuliyen Radulski – one of Bulgaria's brightest grandmasters, who left not only significant sporting achievements but also a deep human mark in the hearts of all who knew him. Yuliyen was an exceptionally kind and balanced person – calm, reserved, always smiling and delicate. He possessed a rare kindness and was always ready to lend a hand to both his colleagues and young chess talents.

He sincerely believed in the power of chess to educate, inspire, and build character. He never refused to take the time to share his knowledge, experience, and love for the game with youngsters. He encouraged them with patience and love, helping them grow not only as competitors but also as individuals.

The Memorial aims to honor his human and sporting legacy, popularize chess, and continue to inspire future generations with the example Yuliyen left us.

2. ORGANIZATION OF THE TOURNAMENT:

Within the Fifth "Yuliyen Radulski Memorial" 2026 tournament, two separate tournaments will be held: Tournament A – open, participation for competitors with a rating <2400. Tournament B - for children up to 12 years old (born after 31.12.2013).

3. RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE

All chess players who apply for participation by January 25, 2026, and pay their tournament fee by bank transfer have the right to participate in tournaments A and B.

4. PARTICIPATION FEES:

- Tournament A: 40 euros;
- Seniors 60+: 20 euros
- Grandmasters (GM and WGM) are exempt from participation fees.
- Tournament B: 20 euros

The organizers reserve the right not to allow players to participate who have, in the past or during the tournament, created tension and violated the basic principles of the world chess movement. GENS UNA SUMUS!

SYSTEM OF PLAY

The tournaments will be held in 7 rounds according to the Swiss system, in accordance with the FIDE tournament rules and FIDE chess regulations. The playing pairs will be determined using Swiss Manager software.

GAME CONTROL: The time control for both tournaments will be 60 minutes per player until the end of the game, with an increment of 30 seconds added before each move played, starting from the first.

TOURNAMENT VALIDITY: Both tournaments will be valid for FIDE classical chess rating.

If a competitor among women or seniors wins an award, their place is released for the next ranked participant in the general classification. Special prizes are won in the announced order in descending order according to the ranking.

- The tournament will be held in accordance with FIDE Regulations.
