

- The definition of the athletes who will attend in the control will be made by the representatives of FISU Medical Committee and NADO;
- After the end of the competition, the contracted Doctor will approach the selected athletes and will indicate that he/she must be present in the antidoping control and shall be accompanying by them until the procedure is completed.

### System & Rate of Play:

- The championship will be based on Swiss system in accordance with the FIDE Rules of Chess.
- The playing time will be 90 minutes for the whole games with an increment of 30 seconds per move, starting from move one.
- We will not use move counter in the clock.



#### Ranking & Tie-Break System:

The order of players that finish with the same number of points shall be determined by application of the following tie-breaking procedures in sequence, proceeding from (a) to (b) to (c) to (d) to (e) the extent required:

- (a) Results of direct encounters between the tied players (applies only if all tied
- players have played each other),
- (b) Buchholz Cut 1,
- (c) Buchholz,
- (d) The greater number of games played with black,
- (e) The Greater number of wins.

#### Appeals Procedure:

Protests against decisions of the Chief Arbiter must be submitted in written form to the Chairman of the appeals committee within one hour after the end of the playing session. The protest must be accompanied with the sum of € 200, as a deposit from the signatory. If the appeal is granted, the sum shall be returned immediately.

The appeal has to be lodged by the player.
The decisions of the Appeals Committee are final.

#### **Default time:**

Default time is 15 minutes after start of the round for all rounds.




#### Offer a draw rule:

There is no restriction to offer a draw during the game but in case of pre-arranged results the chief arbiter can decide that the result of the respective game is 0:0.

### **Playing Venue:**

The 'playing venue' is defined as the 'playing area', rest rooms, toilets, refreshment area, area set aside for smoking and other places as designated by the chief arbiter.

Only with the permission of the arbiter a player can leave the playing venue.



#### Anti-cheating measures for the tournament:

We will have all live-boards transmitted with 15 minutes delay.

Random checks after the round with handheld device and thorough physical check by an arbiter of the same gender.



#### Mobile phone:

During play, a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone and/or other electronic means of communication in the playing venue. If it is evident that a player who brought such a device into the playing venue, shall lose the game. The opponent shall win.



The arbiter may require the player to allow his clothes, bags or other items to be inspected, in private.

The arbiter or a person authorised by the arbiter shall inspect the player and shall be of the same gender as the player. (11.3 FIDE Law of Chess)

#### Draw of lots - color for the first board:

For men competition and for women competition.

#### Pairing of the first round:

The pairing for the first round will be ready in two hours after the end of the Technical Meeting.
