MINUTES OF TECHNICAL MEETING

- > Strict silence should be maintained in the playing hall
- > The tournament will be played in Swiss system
- Total Number of Rounds: 11 ROUNDS
- ➤ Rate of Play: Time control of 90 minutes each with an increment of 30 seconds per move from move no.1
- Default Time: The default timing for arriving at the chess board is 15 minutes. Those who arrive at the board 15 minutes after the start of the game will be declared lost.
- > Draw Offer: Players shall not agree for a draw before Black's 30th move, without the consent of the arbiter.
- Tiebreak Buchholz Cut 1, Buchholz, Sonneborn-Berger, Direct Encounter, Greater Number of Victories (forfeit included) and Number of wins with black pieces
- Electronic Devices: All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall.
- Analysis is not allowed in the playing hall
- As long as the game is in progress, a player may talk only to an arbiter or to his opponent as permitted by the Laws of Chess
- Players who have finished their game will be treated only as spectators and are not allowed in the playing hall

- > During the game, players are forbidden to use any notes, sources of information or advice, or analyse any game on another chessboard
- ➤ The arbiter may require the player to allow his/her clothes, bags or other items to be inspected, in private. The arbiter or a person authorized by the arbiter shall inspect the player and shall be of the same gender as the player. If a player refuses to cooperate with these obligations, the arbiter shall take measures in accordance with Article 12.9
- Player has to inform the Chief Arbiter in writing about his withdrawal from the tournament or absence to any particular round in prior.
- In the event of absence to any round without prior information to the Chief Arbiter in writing, the player's name would be removed from the player's list for further rounds.
- Withdrawals: If any player withdraws from the last two rounds in any National Championship on medical grounds, he/she should undergo treatment by a Doctor recommended and supervised by the tournament committee.
- ➤ Players from the same state will not be paired against each other in the final round of the Championship. However, if no compatible opponent is available within the same score group (or within a maximum difference of 1 point), players from the same state may be paired. This regulation is applicable only to players in the top 50% score group at the end of the penultimate round.
- Protests, If any, against the decision of the chief arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.3,000/- within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
