





II. Ernő Dede Memorial



The aim of the tournament: To commemorate Ernő Dede Jr., FIDE Master, chess player, one of the founding members of the Hajdúszoboszló Chess School, and to provide high-quality competition opportunities with special attention to young chess players.

Organizer: Hajdúszoboszló Chess School

Location: Municipal Sports Center of Hajdúszoboszló (address: 4200 Hajdúszoboszló, Rákóczi Street 60.)

Date: 5-8 February 2026 (Thursday-Sunday)

Arbiters: IA Csaba Horváth as Chief Arbiter; the arbiters will be annuanced at the opening ceremony

Participants of the competition:

Group "A": players between 1900-2399 Elo-rating

Group "B": players under 1900 Elo-rating

Group "C": players under 1600 Elo-rating and under 14-year-old (born on or after 1.1.2012)

Players must have a valid Hungarian Playing Licence which can be paid together with the registration fee. It's 20 EUR for 365 days starting from the paying date.


Format & System: In Group "A" and "B" 7 rounds, in Group "C" 9 rounds Swiss system (FIDE Dutch System) tournament with Swiss Manager program, according to FIDE Laws of Chess

Time control: Group "A" and "B": 2 x 90 minutes + 30 seconds bonus time/move, starting

from move 1

Group "C": 2 x 60 minutes + 30 seconds bonus time/move, starting from

move 1





Default time: 30 minutes

The entry fee for youth players (born on or after 1.1.2008) is 20 EUR in all groups, regardless of the Elo-rating of the player.

Clubs that enter at least 5 youth players will have one youth player's entry fee free of charge.

Above 1850 Elo-rating it's possible to play in Group "A" by paying an additional fee of 8 EUR, only with the organizer's special permission, after discussed via e-mail.





In each group, the 1-3. places will receive a trophy and a medal, and the 1-6. places will receive a certificate. All special prize winners get a trophy. The cumulation of prizes is not possible, each player can receive one prize, the higher one. The prizes are taxable. Prizes are paid in cash, in HUF. The prize money is guaranteed for at least 130 entries in the three groups combined. Prizes can only be collected in person at the awards ceremony.

Among those attending the award ceremony, we will raffle a weekend family vacation in Füzérkomlós, courtesy of the Öreg Bence guesthouse.


In disputes, the applicable rules in force shall prevail.
