As per FIDE Rule We shall provide chess clocks to all the boards

We enclose DD/Chennai Cheque No. for Rs. favouring All India Chess Federation as Tournament Registration Fee Plus FIDE fee of Rs. We shall forfeit this amount if the event is not held at the place and on the dates allocated.

Declaration

I/We guarantee that we shall collect all dues and remit to the AICF including AICF Players Registration fee from players who are not already registered with AICF. We further guarantee that we shall send all the reports to AICF along with IT3 form (Chief Arbiter Report form in print and duly signed by the Chief Arbiter of the event must declare that all the boards are provided with chess clocks) within 7 days of the end of Tournament / championship, failing which, we will be liable to pay a penalty of 70 Euros Charged by FIDE. As per the AICF rule I will not charge entry fee more than 0.5% upto 5 days event or maximum of 1% can be charged in case event extents to more than 5 days of the Prize money. We undertake to provide chess clocks in all the boards.


