

# Monmohon International Invitational Fide Rating Chess Tournament -2026

24-26 March, 2026

## Tournament Rules

The tournament shall be played in a single round robin league system and will be governed by FIDE - the official laws of chess, coming into force on 1 January 2018.

### Time Control

The time control for each game is: 60 minutes for whole game with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move 1.

### Default Time

The default time is the same as the time control. Player will lose by default if his time shows 0:00 after the clock is started. In the case of absence of both player, Organizer may re-schedule the game with agreement by players.

### Tie-Breaking

Default Tiebreaking system will be applied for ranking only. Prize money will be shared.

## Some important Rules

1. The 'playing venue' is defined as the 'playing area', rest rooms, toilets, refreshment area, area set aside for smoking and other places as designated by the arbiter.
2. During play the players are forbidden to use any notes, sources of information or advice, or analyses any game on another chessboard.
3. During play, a player is forbidden to have a mobile phone and/or other electronic means of communication in the playing venue. If it is evident that a player brought such a device into the playing venue, she shall lose the game. If a player refuses to cooperate with these obligations, the arbiter shall take measures in accordance with Article 12.9.
4. Players who have finished their games shall be considered to be spectators.
5. It is forbidden to distract or annoy the opponent in any manner whatsoever. This includes unreasonable claims, unreasonable offers of a draw or the introduction of a source of noise into the playing area.
