TOURNAMENT RULES

TIME CONTROL: 90 MIN + 30 SEC INCREMENT FROM MOVE 1.

DEFAULT TIME (WALK OVER TIME) : 30 MINUTES.

Eligibility :

- A total of 15 (Fifteen) players from each North Eastern States can participate in the tournament. The host state Mizoram can fill unlimited player entries. If any association fails to send its full quota of selected player, the vacancies will not be filled.
- All the entries, normal & special must, come through the concerned state association.

AICF Registration : AICF registration for the year 2025-26 is compulsory for all participants. Application for new players are available online at the AICF portal : <https://prs.aicf.in/new-register>

System of Play : The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss System. A total of **nine rounds** shall be played. Chief Arbiter shall have the right to make any deviation from the declared schedule. Any time during the game the chief Arbiter has the right to hold the game for any sepecial situation.

Tie Break : The Following will be the **order of tie-break** :

- a) Buchholz Cut 1.
- b) Buchholz.
- c) Sonneborn berger
- d) Direct Encounter
- e) The greater number of wins (forfeit include)
- f) Number of wins with black pieces

Note : In case of tie, cash prize will not be shared.

Draw by Agreement : Player shall not agree for a draw without the consent of the arbiter, before each player make 30 move.

Electronic Devices : All electronic items including any types of wrist watches are not allowed in the Tournament Hall. Player in possession of these items may be declared disqualified.

Dress Code : As per AICF regulations on dress code for players participating in North East championships, all State Associations should send their players including special entry players with proper state uniforms. Players without proper uniforms will not be permitted to take part in the championship. This will be strictly enforced.

Expenditure : All Expenditure for participation in the Tournament will be borned by the players themselves.

Protests : Protests, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.2,000/- within 30 minute of the occurrence of the incident. The amount shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeals Committee : Before the commencement of the tournament, a five-member Appeals Committee shall be formed by the AICF/Organizers. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final and binding on players concerned

Chess Clock : Each participating State Chess Association must provide at least one clock in working order for every two players entered into the Championship.

Interpretation : For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. However, such changes/ or inclusion will be subject to AICF clearance. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

Accommodation : Free dormitory accommodation will be provided to all the selected and one manager of the concerned state will be provided. Players and one Manager from each state. States availing the facility must inform the organizers before 5th December 2025. Special entries, players, and accompanying persons will have to make their arrangements for their stay.

ENTRY FEE : All Entry fees should be submitted by online transfer (Gpay, Paytm etc) payment of entry fee (Screenshot) should share through whatapps.

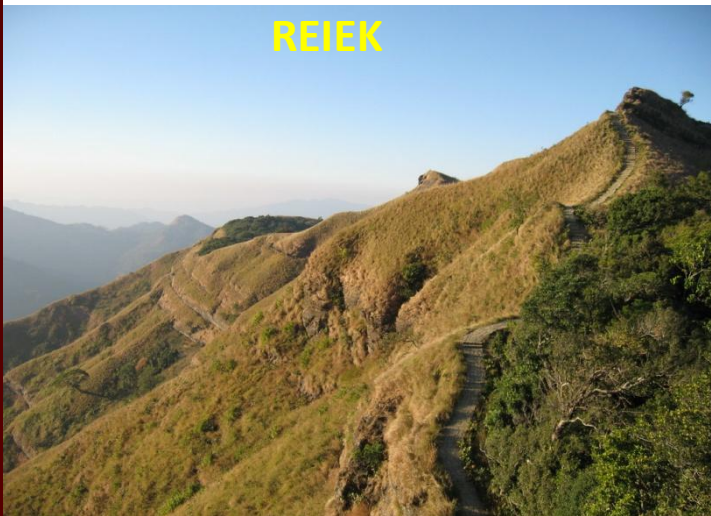
