Minutes of Technical Meeting

- 1. System of Play: Swiss Team
- 2. Total No of Rounds: 7
- 3. Rate of Play: 90 Minutes + 30 Seconds Increment per move
- 4. A Default time of 15 Minutes will be applied. Any Player who arrives at the chessboard after the default time shall lose the game unless the arbiter decides.

General Instructions:

- ➤ All FIDE Rules effective from 1st July 2025 are applicable.
- ➤ Match Points: Win = 2, Draw = 1, Lost = 0.
- Match Points to bye team as 1 and Game points also 2.
- Analysis is not allowed in the Tournament Hall.
- During the game, players shall not talk with their team members.
- ➤ Pairings will be displayed and uploaded to chess-results website.
- ➤ 1st Illegal move is penalized by adding 2 minutes to the opponent. 2nd Illegal same player occurred game lost as per the FIDE Rules.
- Violation of Article 3.1 to 3.9 is Illegal.
- > Using 2 Hands to play while castling, pawn promotion and capture is illegal.
- Pressing the clock without making the move is Illegal.
- > Promoting the pawn is last rank and without replacing it with required piece and pressing the clock is illegal and by default it is gueen.
- ➤ Using 1 hand to play and other hand to press the clock is forbidden but it is not illegal.
- Decision of Touch piece violation cannot be protested.
- ➤ If a player touches his piece, he must make a move with that piece only, if a legal move is possible.

- ➤ If he touches his opponent's piece, he must capture it, if a legal move is possible.
- To adjust the piece or pieces he should say "I adjust" then he can adjust but it should be loud and not simultaneously.
- ➤ If a Piece is required, it can be claimed from the arbiter, do not deep inverted rook, it is any way rook only and not queen.
- ➤ FIDE FPP Regulations: Fide fair play procedures will be enforced in this tournament.

Board Order:

- ➤ Fixed Board Order must submit by Captain at the end of the Technical Meeting.
- Each team shall comprise four players and two reserve.
- > Round Team List to be submitted before 8 PM on the day prior to the round.
- ➤ IF Round Team List (RTL) is not submitted on time, Fixed Board Order will be taken.

Order of RTL:

- > A Higher Board Player cannot play in a Lower Board
- ➤ If players play in wrong order, One point will be deducted from each deviation.

Tiebreaks:

- Match Point (Total of points: 2 for win, 1 for draw and zero for loss)
- > Game Point (Total wins and draws for each team in each match)
- Extended Direct Encounter for Teams
- Extended SB for Teams

Any Protest Against a decision by the Chief Arbiter must be submitted within half an hour of completion of the Respective Match by the Team's Captain to the Organizer, along with a fee of Rs.1000/- which will be returned in case appeal is upheld.

Protest or and appeal committee member cannot be from a same team, in that case player will be excused and Reserve committee member will be chosen. Following is the 3 Member committee, with 2 Members in reserve.

Role of the Captain in Brief:

- ➤ To submit Round Team List for each Game, if necessary
- ➤ To check the results after each match and submit the signed Match Protocol Sheet, together with the score sheets to the Arbiter.
- ➤ In matters relating directly to the play, the captain alone is entitling to lodge or present demands made by his player.
- ➤ The captain is permitted to appoint a deputy to exercise his functions but must inform to the Chief Arbiter of this in writing.
- ➤ He shall not discuss the ongoing games with any of his players.
- ➤ He shall not indicate flag fall.

Points to Note:

- > FIDE Standard Laws will be followed.
- > Mobile phone and any type of wrist watch not allowed as per AICF rules
- No analysis in the tournament hall
- No player shall discuss with their team mates.
- Manager / Non-playing players must keep the mobile in switched off mode.
- Writing of Moves is compulsory.
