GROUPA

Chess Players with Fide Int. Rating more than or equal to 1800

GROUP B

Chess Players with Fide Int. Rating less or equal to 2000 aged above 12 years old (born before 1/1/2014) and players with Int, Rating more than 1600 under 12 (born after 1/1/2014)

GROUP C

Chess Players with Fide Rating less or equal to 1800 aged under 12 (born after 1/1/2014)

Time Control

Ninety (90) minutes for the whole game, plus thirty (30) seconds per move (from the first move).

Players arriving thirty (30') minutes and more, after the scheduled start of a round, shall be forfeited.

The participation fee will be refunded in full if cancellation is requested by Friday, February 13.

Otherwise, it will be forfeited in favor of the organization.

Draws Exceptions Byes

- The draw for the first round will take place on Thursday (February 19) at 15:30 and will be announced on chess results.
- Players who do not finalize their participation on time will participate from the second (2nd) round.
- For the convenience of the players, an exception from the draw for subsequent rounds may be requested up to ten (10) minutes after the end of the last game
- Until the third (3rd) round, players can get an exception by taking half (½) a point, and from the 4th round onwards without a point.
- Exception in the 1st round is only granted to those who have paid the participation fee in advance.
- Absence from any round without informing the organisers will automatically result in disqualification from the tournament.
- If a player is unable to attend a round, they must inform the arbiter ten (10) minutes after the end of their last game.
- Postponements of matches and changes to the start time are not permitted for any reason.
- If any athlete unjustifiably loses a game without playing and without informing the organizers, they will not be eligible to participate in the next "Vardaris" tournament.

Participants

The limit is set at 350 participants.

Importand Notice

Concerning all the athletes, who travel from all over Greece and abroad to honor us with their participation in the tournament, any chess player who does not show up for a round without notification will not be accepted in the next Vardaris Tournament.
