Fujairah Chess & Culture Club is pleased to invite you to participate in the 1st Fujairah Global Chess Championship, which will be held in FUJAIRAH-UAE from 24th August - 3rd September 2025.

Participants & Registration:

- 1.1. The tournament is open to all FIDE players in the following categories:
- 1.1.1 Superstars Tournament: (All players with <u>conditions</u> hotel & compensation for an air ticket) FIDE rated 2600 & higher.
 - 1.1.2 Masters Tournament: FIDE rated 2200-2599.
 - 1.1.3 Youth-Open Tournament: FIDE players rated below 2200 regardless to age. Considered ratings are the FIDE Standard Rating List for August 2025.
- 1.1.4 PLAYERS RATED FROM 2560 TO 2599 CAN CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE EITHER IN MASTERS OR IN SUPERSTARS TOURNAMENT.
- 1.2. Registration is only accepted online via the following Link: https://form.jotform.com/FCCC/1st-fujairah-global-chess-champion
- 1.3. The last day of registration is 31st July 2025.
 - 1.3.1 Late Registration fees will be applied after this date.
- **1.3.2** in case player rating does not meet tournament regulations for **FIDE** standard rating list for August 2025, Conditions and tournament category will be changed to match the player rating according to the tournament regulation.
 - 1.3.3 Unpaid application will be rejected automatically.
- **1.4.** All participating players and accompanying persons agree to fully comply with the rules and regulations of the tournament organizer & the United Arab Emirates.
- **1.5.** The organizing committee reserves the right to accept or deny a participant's registration according to FIDE Rules and regulations and UAE Laws.
- **1.6.** The organizing Committee reserves the right to issue special approvals to include lower-rated players in the master's tournament only.



Number of Rounds & Time Control:

- 2.1. 9 Rounds Swiss System.
- 2.2. Time Control: 90 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move for the whole game.
- 2.3. Default Time: 30-minutes.
- **2.4. Draw Offer:** Players cannot offer or agree to a draw before 30 moves are played on the board by both players.

Playing Venue:

3.1 The Tournament venue will be Fujairah Chess & Culture Club - New Building.

4.1. Based on FIDE Standard rating & title as of 1st August 2025.

- 4.2. Online ratings/titles are not included in the above table.
- 4.3. The entry fees cover solely tournament participation.
- 4.4. Late Registration Fees is USD 50.
- 4.5. Registration fee are non-refundable.



- **5.2.** Main Prizes will be awarded based on Hort-System <u>for the given number of</u> places only.
- 5.3. Special Prizes will be awarded based on tie-breaks and will not be shared.
- **5.4.** A player may not receive more than one prize. In cases where a participant qualifies for different awards, the prize with the higher monetary value will be awarded, and any remaining prize will be given to the next-ranked player.
- 5.5. Winners of the Tournament must be present at the closing ceremony.
- 5.6. Absent Winners' Prizes will be canceled.
- **5.7.** Prize winners must adhere to a business casual, elegant casual, or smart casual dress code. Shorts and slippers are not allowed.

- 1.Buchholz Cut 1.
- 2.Direct encounter.
- 3.Median Buchholz.
- 4.Greater number of wins played by Black.

Hotel Accommodation:

6.1. The official hotels will be decided later.



Hosting Condition:

- **7.1.** Grandmasters with a standard Elo of **2700+** are eligible to get **free single room accommodation with full board and \$1000 compensation for an air ticket.** subject to FIDE rating list of August 2025, and approval.
- **7.2.** Grandmasters with a standard Elo of **2650+** are eligible to get **free single room accommodation with full board and \$700 compensation for an air ticket.** subject to FIDE rating list of August 2025, and approval.
- **7.3.** Grandmasters with a standard Elo of **2600+** are eligible to get **free single room accommodation with full board and \$500 compensation for an air ticket.** subject to FIDE rating list of August 2025, and approval.
- **7.4. 15 Grandmasters + 5 Female players (of masters tournament)** will be invited and may apply for **free single room accommodation with full board & \$500 compensation for an air ticket.** by submitting the condition form. subject to the FIDE rating list 1st of August 2025, and approval.
- **7.5.** The last day for accepting Accommodation & compensation for Air Ticket Condition applicants is **25th July 2025**.
- **7.6.** Applying for accommodation does not automatically make the player eligible to get a condition.
- **7.7.** If a participant's application for accommodation is accepted, the organizer will contact the player directly with an <u>official form to be signed and returned</u> as instructed through the email.

Invited Players (Arrival/Departure)

- 8.3. Entry visas will only be issued to invited players who require them. Other players may request an invitation letter, which can be used for visa purposes.

Additional Rules:

- **11.1.** All players are expected to adhere to the dress code at all times during the event. This includes the playing hall and awards ceremony. Participants who do not comply with the dress code regulations may face penalties from the organizing committee.
- 11.2. Smoking is forbidden in the playing hall.
- **11.3.** After each game, players must submit the original scoresheets, signed by both players, to the arbiter.
- **11.4.** Players who have finished their games shall be considered as spectators and are not allowed to stay in the playing area.
- **11.5.** Players are asked not to bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices (even switched off) into the playing hall. Bringing any device to the playing hall will result in a forfeit.
- **11.6.** The arbiter may require the player to allow his clothes, bags, or other items to be inspected, in private. The arbiter or a person authorized by the arbiter for inspection shall be of the same gender as the player. If a player refuses to cooperate with these obligations, the arbiter shall take measures following Article 12.9. of the Laws of Chess.
- 11.7. Random checks of players may be carried out before and after every game.
- 11.8. Fair Play measures will be taken according to the FIDE Anti cheating regulations.
- 11.9. The players shall take no action that will bring the game of chess into disrepute.
- 11.10. Players are obliged to obey Tournament Regulations.
- **11.11.** Pictures may be only taken with flash during the first ten minutes of the rounds. After that, only Media representatives holding an accreditation are allowed to film or photograph in the playing hall.
- **11.12.** Only players and arbiters shall be allowed in the actual playing area. Exceptions may only be granted by the Tournament Organizer and Chief Arbiter.
