TOURNAMENT RULES

System of Play:

The tournament will be conducted as per the latest **FIDE Laws of Chess** and **Swiss System** with **7 rounds (OPEN) & 6 rounds (Under 11)**.

Time Control: 15 Minutes + 10 Seconds Increment from Move 1.

Reporting Time: 9:00 AM

Round 1 Starts: 9:30 AM

BELOW 1700 RATING ELIGIBILITY

The Below 1700 Open section is open to players with a FIDE Rapid Rating below 1700, as per the FIDE Rapid Rating List dated 1 October 2026. **Unrated players are eligible.**

Tie Break: In case of a tie, the latest FIDE tie break rules shall apply. Player shall be eligible for only one higher prize.

Wrist Watches & Mobile Phones: Players are instructed not to wear wrist watches. Mobile phones must be kept in switch off mode. Violation of either rule may result in loss of the game.

Protest: In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be final. Organizers reserve the right to accept or reject entries without assigning any reason

Entry Policy: Entry fees are strictly non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.

Prize Rules:

- **Best Veteran:** Players aged 55 years or above on the date of the tournament.
- **Best Specially Abled:** Minimum 50% disability with a valid Disability Certificate
- **Best School Team and Best Academy** Team will be decided based on the combined score of the top 4 players from the same school and academy.

Parent Guidelines:

- A separate waiting area will be available for parents and guardians.
- PARENTS AND GUARDIANS ARE **NOT PERMITTED** INSIDE THE PLAYING HALL.
- Tournament officials will assist players in locating their boards and tables.
- To ensure a fair and distraction free playing environment, only players, arbiters and authorised officials are allowed inside the playing area.
