Technical Regulations

- 1.1. FIDE rated Swiss system will be used with 9 rounds played. The Championships shall be governed by the General Regulations for FIDE Competitions.
- 1.2. There shall be 03 categories: Under 10

Under 13, Under 17 with separate events for Boys/Open and Girls (in total 06 championships).

Entitled to participate in each category are:

- Under 10: Players born on or after January 1st 2015,
- Under 13: Players born on or after January 1st 2012,
- Under 17: Players born on or after January 1st 2008. (Note: Currently Grade
- 10 or lower are only allowed)
- 1.3. Time control is 60 minutes plus 30 seconds increment from move one.
- 1.4. Default time is 15 minutes. Any player who arrives at the chessboard after the default time shall lose the game unless the Chief Arbiter decides otherwise.
- 1.5. The final ranking order of the players is determined by the number of points scored. If two or more players are tied for the first place or for any prize, the tie shall be broken in the following order:
- Direct Encounter points (applies only if all tied players have played each other),
- b. Buchholz Cut 1,
- c. Buchholz,
- d. Greater Number of Wins with Black Pieces,
- e. Greater Number of Wins.
- f. Rating Performance

Prizes, Titles & Certificates

- 1.6. The top ten participants in each category will receive a trophy, medal, a special cash award.
- 1.7. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
- 1.8. Total Cash prize is 3,00,000/- Nepali Rupees.
- 1.9. Best Three School will be awarded with Trophy.

Invitation

This is the official invitation to all national chess federations, members of FIDE and eligible players to participate in the 2nd International Inter-School Chess Championship 2025 (categories for boys/open and girls under 10, 13 and 17 years old). The championships will be held in Budhanilkantha Kathmandu, Nepal from December 3rd to 6th 2025 under the auspices of TIA School, Nepal Chess Federation and Budhanilkantha Municipality. Budhanilkantha Municipality, located at the northern edge of Kathmandu Valley, is renowned for its sacred Vishnu temple, natural beauty, and as a gateway to Shivpuri National Park.

Venue, Date & Schedule

The championship will be held in TIA School "Budhanilkantha", Kathmandu, Nepal, from December 03rd (arrival date) until December 05th (departure date) 2025. The playing venue will be TIA School Premises.

Appeals procedure and Appeals Committee

- The Appeals Committee consists of 3 persons, one of whom may be the FIDE Technical Delegate. Two additional reserve members will be appointed at the Technical Meeting as no member shall take part in a decision affecting a player of his own federation.
- 1.11. A protest against the Chief Arbiters' decisions must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee within one hour after the completion of the respective game. The protest must be accompanied with the sum of NRS 5000/-, as a deposit. If the appeal is granted, the sum shall be returned immediately. If the appeal is refused, the deposit is forfeited to FIDE. The Appeals Committee may also decide to refund the fee if it considers the appeal to be non-frivolous. The decisions of the Appeals Committee are final.
- 1.12. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final, binding, and takes effect immediately.

NRs.3000/- for international players (incl. lodging & food).

Payments

After the registration form has been filled in, send to the organizer and approved by the organizer, the national federations will receive pro-forma invoices for bank payments. Once the bank transfer is validated, the Organizing Committee will confirm the assigned booking confirmation for all the rooms.

Registration fees for the late registration, withdrawal or no show is non refundable.

Anti-Cheating Measures

The organizer will implement strict measures to prevent any possible cheating attempts. This implies detailed control before entering the playing hall, delayed transfer of games, control of the playing venue and prevention of any mutual verbal and non-verbal communication.

The Chief Arbiter will be encouraged to devise a system for conducting random checks during the tournament.

Medical Service

Players have to insure themselves against health risks and accidents for the duration of the Championship.

The standard voltage in Nepal is 220 Volts. The local currency is Rupees (NRS). Weather: The average high temperature is around 17° C to 20° C.




