



## Festival Caissa – Chalice Rapid FIDE Rating Chess Tournament

Organized by Innovators Chess Academy on January 25, 2026 at Silicon City Academy of Secondary Education, Konanakunte, Bangalore. Register on [www.icachess.in](http://www.icachess.in). Total Prize fund: Rs 10 lacs.

Players meeting: 8.30 am. Round 1 starts at 9 am.

### Registration:

#### Entry fee structure:

Entries received until January 19 2026: Rs 5000/-

Entries received after January 19 2026 until January 23 2026: Rs 6000/- (including Rs 1000 late fee)

Discounted entry fee for players registering to all 4 FIDE Rating Events – Navaratna, Crown, Chalice and Sceptre – Rs 10,000/- (total discount of Rs 1,500) is valid until October 31, 2025.

Entry fees is non-refundable and non-transferrable. Free entry to all Grandmasters and International Masters. They will have to take care of their accommodation on their own.

### Festival Caissa and The Grand Prix System

Festival Caissa constitutes four FIDE Rating Events – 1 Blitz and 3 Rapid Events. While the Blitz Event takes place on January 23, 2026, the three Rapid FIDE Rating Chess Tournaments — Crown, Chalice and Sceptre — will be held on January 24, 25, and 26, 2026 respectively.

Prize winners from all these events will earn Grand Prix points. In addition, the best unrated player, the best player rated below 1900 and 1600, the best Veteran and the overall winner in each of the Festival's FIDE Rating Events (Blitz and Rapid) will receive 100 Grand Prix points. Any player accumulating 400 Grand Prix points during Festival Caissa will be awarded a bonus of ₹1,00,000. There are Grand Prix Points also awarded for Children in Chalice and Sceptre FIDE Rapid Rating Events – in the U8, U10 and U12 age categories.

The top 40 players with the highest Grand Prix points accumulated across the four FIDE-rated Festival events will qualify for the Grand Prix Finals — a 7-round Swiss Blitz tournament with a time control of 3 minutes plus a 2-second increment. The Finals will be held on January 26, 2026, at 6:45 PM. Further details on our website – [icachess.in](http://icachess.in). Players who are tied on the same Grand Prix points as the 40th-placed player will also qualify for the Grand Prix Finals.

## Venue and Metro accessibility:

Silicon City Academy of Secondary Education is located at Kumar Nursery, Off Kanakapura Rd, New Bank Colony, 8th Phase, Konanakunte, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560062. The Venue is 1.5 km from the Konanakunte Cross Metro Station. The school has hosted more than 100 Chess Tournaments since 2012.

## Rules and Regulations

- 1) All Indian Citizen players with a valid AICF ID for the current financial year 2025-26 are eligible to participate, regardless whether they are rated or unrated. To register/renew your AICF Membership, please refer the link: <https://prs.aicf.in/players>. Foreign nationals need not have an AICF Membership.
- 2) All players from Karnataka must provide their KSCA ID at the time of registration. To register/renew your KSCA membership, please refer the link below

- 3) Tie break for the Event will be announced and explained in the Players Meeting. The same will be published on the Notice Board during the Tournament.
- 4) Default time (Walkover time): The default time will be 5 minutes.
- 5) A five-member Appeals Committee shall be formed during the Players Meeting.
- 6) Any protest against a decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be submitted in writing within 10 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a protest fee of ₹1,000/-. The fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld. The decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final and binding on all participants.
- 7) Participation Certificate: E-Certificates will be provided to all participants. The same will be uploaded within 15 days from the conclusion of the Event on [icachess.in](http://icachess.in).
- 8) Possession of any electronic device, including wristwatches, during play is strictly prohibited. Violation may result in forfeiture of the game.
- 9) Festival Caissa will have International Arbiters Vasanth BH, Murugasundaram and Sahana Subramanya officiating in all the four FIDE Rating Tournaments.
- 10) The Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess – FIDE Swiss System of 9 Rounds.
- 11) FIDE IDs will be generated during the Event – this is for players who do not have a FIDE ID.
- 12) Parents and non-participants are not allowed inside the Tournament Hall during play.
- 13) Prize Money will be transferred online within two weeks from the date of completion of the Event.
- 14) Time Control - 15 Minutes each with 5 seconds increment from move number one.
