# REGULATIONS

**1. ORGANIZERS:** Chess club "Etar", "FIDE International Academy BULCHESS"

### 2. SYSTEM AND VALIDITY - Two tournaments:

A tournament - Swiss system, 9 rounds, for all players

B tournament – Swiss system, 7 rounds, for players with rating under 2200

Tournaments are valid for international rating

#### 3. RATE OF PLAY:

For A tournament - 90 minutes per player per game with inscription of 30 seconds per move.

For B tournament - 60 minutes per player per game with inscription of 30 seconds per move.

- **4. CHESS CLOCKS**: licensed by FIDE models.
- **5. PARTICIPANTS:** Players accepting the terms and conditions of this Regulation and approved by the organizers.
- **6. ACCOMMODATION:** Hotel Forest beach and Les Magnolias. Rates are per person, per day and on All Inclusive Single room 90 BGN Double room 79 BGN Triple room 79 BGN

Accommodation in a double room of an adult with a child under the age of 7 till the date of 14.09.2025, 97 BGN per day will be charged. For accommodation in a double room of an adult with a child under the age of 12 till the date of 14.09.2025, 137 BGN per day will be charged. The same principle applies when accommodating 1 adult with more children in the same room.

The players can use "bye" with ½ point from rounds 1-6 in A tournament and 1-5 in B tournament. They must inform the chief arbiter in advance not latter than 10 minutes after the end of the last game of the previous round. \*The chief arbiter is allowed to make changes in the schedule after consultation with the organizers. In case of changes in the schedule it will be published in written in the playing venue.

**9. STANDINGS:** according to the points earned. In case of a tie, the following tie-breaks are applied consistently: Direct encounter (The results of the player in the same point group; Reduced Buchholz (-1); Buchholz; Greater number of victories; Sonneborn-Berger. The tie-breaks are calculated according to the parameters set in the FIDE-approved computer program Swiss-Manager.

### **Reserve members:**

Appeals are submitted no later than 30 minutes after the arbiter's decision, accompanied by a fee of BGN 60 (sixty), and are handed in writing to the Chairman or a member of the Tournament Committee. The decision of the Tournament Committee is final. In case the appeal is accepted, the amount is returned to the player immediately. In case it is rejected, the amount remains in favour of the organizers. No appeals are accepted regarding the composition of the pairs for the game, except in case of an obvious technical error.

### 11. MEDICAL SERVICE: according to FIDE tournament regulations

#### 13. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

- 13.1. All players are obliged to comply with the FIDE Chess Regulations and this Regulation and to play their games in the spirit of "fair play".
- 13.2 A player forfeits the game if he hasn't appeared at his board within 30 minutes after the start of the game.

- 13.3. Conversations between the players, between players and coaches and others during games are prohibited.
- 13.4. During the game, players are prohibited from carrying a mobile phone, other electronic means of communication or a device capable of prompting chess moves in the competition area.
- 13.5. It is forbidden to distract or irritate the opponent in any way. This includes unfounded complaints, unfounded draw offers or the introduction of a noise source on the playing field.
- 13.6. The FIDE Laws of chess are available to players
- 13.7. Players who finished their games are considered spectators and are not allowed to remain in the playing halls.
- 13.8. The playing area includes the playing halls in which it takes place and the toilets.
- 13.9. The organizer reserves the right to make any necessary changes to the rules described here, in order to ensure the smooth running of the chess festival.
- 13.10. All participants are familiar with the Regulation and undertake to comply with it.
