VII International Chess Tournament San Cristóbal de La Laguna 2025

Bases

Game System.

The tournament will be played using the Swiss system in 9 rounds, from August 23 to August 30, 2025.

Headquarters.

The tournament will be held in the halls of the former Convent of Santo Domingo, Calle Santo Domingo 7 - 38207 - San Cristóbal de La Laguna, Tenerife - Canary Islands - Spain <u>Location</u>

Schedule.

Matches start at 17:00, except for rounds 2 which start at 10:00 and 9 which starts at 09:30. The closing ceremony will begin on August 31st at 14:00.

The international **active** valid for the Canary Islands active circuit will be held on August 30 and August 31

Initial ranking.

The FIDE ELO rating will be taken into account, and if it does not exist, the alphabetical order. Participants are obliged to verify their personal data, ELO and codes before the start of the tournament. The tournament is valid for obtaining International Standards and FIDE Rating Evaluation.

Pace of play, matchups and draw agreements.

The game will last 90 minutes plus 30 seconds added time per move (Fischer system). Pairings and tie-breaks will be carried out using the Swiss Manager software. The official pairings for all rounds will be made public 6 hours before the start of the round. Before that time, the pairings are not official; they are only drafts, subject to corrections. On days with double rounds, the 6-hour window will be reduced to 1 hour.

A draw cannot be agreed upon in less than 30 moves or one hour of play without the consent of the arbiter.

Non-appearances.

A 30-minute margin is established for the presentation of each player at the game (time is counted from the official start time of each round). Any player who does not show up at the beginning of the first round may be replaced by another participant and will be excluded from the tournament. Players who lose a game due to failure to appear and do not justify their absence to the organization will be disqualified from the tournament. Two failures to appear, justified or not, will result in elimination from the tournament.

Bye /Break Request.

Each player has the possibility of requesting two byes during the tournament, valid in the first six rounds, for which half a point will be awarded and the applicant will not be paired. Requests must be specifically submitted to the tournament's head referee before the beginning of the round preceding the round in which the bye is requested. A player who has committed a forfeit loses the right to request a bye. Guest players cannot have this possibility.

Tiebreakers.

The following tie-breaking systems will apply:

- a) Direct result, to decide the champion of each group.
- b) Recursive performance.
- c) Bucholtz minus the 2 worst results.
- d) Number of victories.

The moves must be recorded on the scoresheets as clearly and legibly as possible, in algebraic notation.

Please note that at this pace of play it is mandatory to record all moves on the scoresheet. A player may reply to an opponent's move before recording it, if he so wishes. He must record his previous move before making another move .

Players are required to hand in the original signed score sheet with the correct result to the referee at the end of the game. Once the game is over, players must return the pieces to their original position.

Game room and electronic devices.

Analysis and replay of games in the game room is not permitted. Players may not leave the game room while the game is in progress without the Referee's permission.

Unless expressly authorized by the referee, it is prohibited to use or carry any communication device, mobile phone, tablet , smart watch , etc. in the game room (including bathrooms) during games. If a player is found to be connected to or using an electronic communication device, he or she will automatically lose the game and will be disqualified from participating in the tournament.

Appropriate conduct for participating in this tournament will require respect for the facilities, appropriate attire, and not consuming or dispersing food or drinks in the room.

Any type of offensive attitude in word or deed from one player to another, referees, organizers or public, will result in immediate disqualification from the tournament.

Players.

Participation open to all federated players during the 2025 season.

Players must be registered. The VII San Cristóbal de La Laguna 2025 International Chess Tournament will be official and will be valid for ELO and FIDE Standards.

Awards.

The prizes are not distributed, they are awarded in strict order of classification, including tie-breakers. All prizes will be subject to the deductions established by current legislation.

Players who win a prize must be present at the closing ceremony of the International Open, otherwise they will lose their right to the prize.

Those born in 2015 and later are considered to be in the **under-10 categories**, those born in 2013 and later are considered to be under **- 12**, those born in 2011 and later are considered to be under-14, **those** born in 2009 and later are considered to be under-16, and **those** born in 1965 and earlier are considered to be under **-16**.

Criteria for awarding prizes

Prizes will be awarded under 2 combined criteria:

- Order of distribution: 1st Overall; 2nd Female; 3rd Best Canary Islander; 4th Best Veteran; 5th
 Best Under 2100 (or Under 1800 for Under 1900 tournament); 6th Best Under 2000 (or Best
 Under 1600 in Under 1900 tournament); 7th Best in the province of Tenerife; 8th Best in the
 province of Las Palmas; 9th Best Player of the Ébano Club, 10th Best Youth Awards, starting with
 the oldest.
 - Geographical awards will be granted by the federations or delegations where the license is held in 2025.
- Highest amount: If you are eligible for several prizes, the highest amount will be received.

This Committee will be made up of the Tournament Director and four players (2 starters and 2 substitutes), chosen from among the participants. The decisions of this Committee will be final and unappealable.

Final provisions.

The tournament is governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess for this type of tournament. In the event of situations not covered by the tournament or these rules, the arbitration decisions ratified by the main arbiter shall prevail and shall be final.

Participation in the tournament implies full acceptance of these rules.
