

PSY 100 jubilee tournament - Blitz

Competition regulations:

1 § Venue and Schedule

Venue: Pori Upper Secondary School, Tasavallankatu 4, Pori

Confirmation of participation: Fri 5th of June at 17:00–17:45

Rounds 1–11: Fri 5th of June at 18:00. A short break after round 6.

2 § General regulations

The tournament will be played in accordance with the FIDE Laws of Chess, FIDE Anti-Cheating Regulations and other FIDE regulations and the competition regulations of Finnish Chess Federation.

The results will be sent to the national rating system (selo) and to FIDE rating system (elo).

Default time is 3 minutes.

3 § Organizing committee

Other officials may be appointed.

4 § Pairing system

11 rounds, Swiss system. Pairings will be made with the Swiss-Manager-program.

5 § Time control

Time control is 3 min + 2 sec / move.

6 § Electronic devices and anti-cheating

Electronic devices are not allowed in the playing area and must be handed to the organizers before entering the playing area. **In case of a violation of this regulation, the game in progress will be forfeited.**

7 § Tiebreaks and regulations on prizes

The order of players that finish with the same number of points shall be determined by the following tie-breaks:

1. Buchholz, no cut
2. Sonneborn-Berger
3. Direct encounter

Prizes will be shared among the players in the same point group. **One player may win multiple cash prizes.**

8 § Prize fund

1. 400 EUR
2. 250 EUR
3. 150 EUR

Best junior (U20): 100 EUR

Best female: 100 EUR

Best senior (S60): 100 EUR

Rating group (U2000): 50 EUR

Rating group (U1700): 50 EUR

9 § Data protection

Due to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR, 2016/679) the organizing committee states the following:

The organizing committee handles personal data of the players and produces the results of the competition. The results will be published. The organizer uses the Swiss-Manager -program and the results will be published online at chess-results.com and in rating calculation sites. The results may also be published in other websites or generally in the media.

Players may also be photographed during the tournament, and the material may also be published. By attending the competition players accept these conditions.

10 § Other

Results and pairings are published on Chess-Results.

Spectators may enter the playing hall, but they are not allowed to disturb the games or use any electronic devices in the playing hall.

Photographing is allowed.
