## **Technical Regulations**

Pairing Program: Latest version of Swiss Manager.

System of Play: Swiss System under FIDE Laws of Chess with 9 Rounds

❖ Time Control: 60 Minutes each + 30 Sec Increment From 1<sup>st</sup> Move

**♦ Default Time**: 15 Minutes

- If a player is absent for a round, he/she should inform the Chief Arbiter before the next round pairing to retain his/her name in the Pairing list. Otherwise, he/she will not be paired for further rounds.
- The Chief Arbiter has the authority not to start the clock of a particular board due to any unforeseen scenarios.

### Tie Break:

- 1) Buchholz Cut 1. 2) Buchholz All. 3) Sonneborn Berger. 4) Direct Encounter
- 5) Greater number of victories (Inclusive forfeit points). 6) Games won with Black Pieces

# Discussion / Analysis:

Analysis is not allowed in the playing hall / playing Arena.

# **❖** Spectators:

Players who have finished their game will be treated as spectators and are not allowed in the playing arena.

### Protest:

Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter or his assistants shall be made in writing with a protest fee of  $\Box$  1,000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident, the protest fee shall be refunded if the appeal is upheld. Only player him/herself (guardian in case of minor) are only allowed to lodge the appeal.

# Chess Etiquette

Players are requested to wear neat dress. Slippers, sunglasses and torn clothes are not allowed. All players and Accompanying persons have to maintain proper Chess Etiquette for entire duration of the tournament.

### Cash Prizes:

Cash prizes will not be shared. A player is eligible for one higher prize only.

# Fair Play Regulations

FIDE and AICF Fair Play Regulations will be enforced. All players are requested to respect the regulations and cooperate with officials.

Players are strictly forbidden to bring mobiles, ear pods/earphones, smart glasses, e-cigarettes, any source of chess information material or any electronic devices or part of electronic device which include all types of watches (mechanical/analogue watches) to the playing arena. If the same found during the game, players are liable to lose the game and further participation in the tournament will be decided by Chief Arbiter on merit of the case.

During the game, players are not to speak with others (except with opponent and arbiter, as permitted in Laws of Chess).

- ➤ Attire that covering the ears (other than religious reasons) are not permitted without the consent of the Chief Arbiter as well as carrying bags, sun glasses, sports cap/hat etc to the tournament hall is prohibited.
- ➤ Leave all metallic items, previous round score sheet etc at your room only. If you need to carry any personal items other than currency, fruits, chocolates etc please use a cloth or transparent bag. Wallet and Small ladies' purse will be allowed.
- > Strictly use the refreshment area for the eatables.
- Any player requires special attention due to medical reasons are requested to intimate the same to Chief Arbiter before start of the first round.

> The Managers, parents and coaches are not to be allowed inside the hall during the game.

### IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- ❖ Pairings will be displayed and uploaded to chess-results.com
- ❖ If the player's name is on left hand side, he will be playing white and if it is on right hand side, he will be playing black.
- ❖ **Bo** is board number
- ❖ 2 illegal moves are lost
- **\*** Each illegal move is penalized by adding 2 minute to the opponent's clock times.
- ❖ Violation of article 3.1 to 3.9 is illegal
- ❖ Using 2 hands to play while castling, pawn promotion and capture is illegal
- ❖ Pressing the clock without making the move is illegal
- ❖ Promoting the pawn to the last rank and without replacing it with a required piece and pressing the clock is illegal and by default it is queen.
- ❖ Using one hand to play and other hand to press the clock is forbidden but it is not illegal.
- ❖ Decision of the Touch piece violation cannot be protested.
- ❖ If a player touches his piece, he has to make a move with that piece only, if a legal move is possible.
- ❖ If he touches his opponent's piece, he has to capture it, if a legal move is possible.
- ❖ To adjust the piece or pieces he should say "I adjust" then he can adjust but it should be loud and not simultaneously.
- ❖ Improper piece or board orientation can be rectified within 10 moves, after 10 moves it cannot be rectified.
- ❖ If a piece is required it can be claimed from the arbiter, do not keep inverted rook, it is any way rook only and not queen.
- ❖ While giving result please tell winners name, never say I won or white won or 1-0 or he won or she Won etc.
