



REGULATIONS 3rd Children's Tournament "Dimitar Karapchanski"

GOAL AND OBJECTIVES: Tournament is held with the intent to develop strong young chess players

DATE AND VENUE: October 10-12, 2025, Sliven Sport Palace Hotel****

FORMAT

The tournament will be held using a 7-round Swiss system. All Bulgarian and foreign chess players born after December 31, 2010, who submit their applications by October 8, 2025, to the email ochkov89@abv.bg and pay the participation fee of 40 BGN, are eligible to participate, subject to approval by the organizers.

Players from the two Sliven-based clubs pay a reduced fee of 30 BGN.

TIME CONTROL: 60 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move from the start of the game

TOURNAMENT VALIDITY: The tournament is valid for FIDE ELO in classical chess.

3rd place – 150 BGN

4th place – 100 BGN

The best-performing girl in each of the following age groups — under 8, under 10, and under 12 — will receive a **€100 voucher for Modern Chess**.

GROUP UNDER 8 – 1st place: Trophy, 2nd and 3rd places: Medal and material prize

GROUP UNDER 10 – 1st place: Trophy, 2nd and 3rd places: Medal and material prize

GROUP UNDER 12 – 1st place: Trophy, 2nd and 3rd places: Medal and material prize

The application must include the player's full name (first, middle, and last), date of birth, club, and FIDE ID.
