



Latvian Student chess championship 2025









1.Goals and tasks.

1.1.To identify Latvian Student Champions: team and individual. In chess. To increase students' chess skills. To popularize chess among students.

2. Competition management.

- 2.1. The competition is organized by: LASS (Latvian Higher Education Sports Union) in cooperation with the Riga Chess Federation, Riga Stradins University and RSU Faculty of Social Sciences.
- 2.2. Chief referee: Alberts Cimiņš (IA/B), tel. 28804664; alberts.cimins@inbox.lv.
- 2.3. Chief secretary: Aivars Laizāns (IA/D).

3.Place.

3.1. Will take place on December 13, 2025 (rapid) and December 14 (blitz), Riga Stradiņš University, Faculty of Social Sciences, Kuldīgas Street 9C, Building A-206.

4. Participants and rules of the competition.

- 4.1. An unlimited number of participants from each university can participate in the championship.
- 4.2.Competition procedure. The competition is held in accordance with the FIDE rapid and blitz rules. Rapid according to the Swiss system in 7 rounds, and Blitz according to the Swiss system in 9 rounds.
- 4.3.Reflection time in rapid 12 minutes until the end of the game for each participant + 5 seconds for each move made.
- 4.4.Reflection time in blitz 5 minutes until the end of the game for each participant + 3 seconds for each move made.
- 4.5. The draw and placement will be carried out by the computer program Swiss Manager.
- 4.6. The FIDE rapid and blitz chess rating will be calculated at the championship.
- 4.7. The head arbiter may decide to change the rules (number of rounds, etc.) based on the number of participants.





5. Evaluation.

- 5.1. The results of high school teams are determined by adding together the 3 best male and 3 best female results.
- 5.2. In case of equal points, individual places are determined by: 1) improved Buholz coefficient (worst result),
- 2) Buholz coefficient, 3) Ranking achievement in the tournament. For teams: Buholz coefficient.

6. Awards.

6.1. 1st-3rd place winners in the women's and men's competition will be awarded with diplomas, medals and 1st places with cups.

7. Admission of participants and applications.

- 7.1. Applications must be submitted by e-mail: alberts.cimins@inbox.lv no later than December 10, 2025, at 18.00, the participant's surname, first name, year of birth, sports class and FIDE rapid chess rating, student ID number and university must be provided.
- 7.2. There is no participation fee.
- 7.3. The participant or the organization that registers the participant for the start is responsible for the participant's health condition.
