## **OPEN TOURNAMENT 1900+ CHESS CLUB RADNICKI KOVIN**



## **RULEBOOK**

- 1. Chess Club Radnicki Kovin organizes Chess Tournament Open 1900+. The Tournament will be held from November 18<sup>TH</sup> to November 23<sup>RD</sup> 2025.
- 2. Open for players higher than 1900 FIDE rating for standard chess. Organizer reserve the right to allow few players with a rating lower than 1900 to participate.
- 3. Tournament will be played according to FIDE Rules and pairing is done by computer according to the Swiss system.
- 4. 9 rounds, time control is 90 minutes with 30 seconds increment starting with move number 1.
- 5. During first six rounds, participant can pick a round to remain unpaired. With half point attributed.
- 6. Recording moves is mandatory until the end of the game.
- 7. The date and time of the games are as follows:

Round 1 18<sup>th</sup> November at 4pm

Round 2 19<sup>th</sup> November at 10am

Round 3 19<sup>th</sup> November at 3pm

Round 4 20<sup>th</sup> November at 10am

Round 5 20th November at 3pm

Round 6 21st November at 4pm

Round 7 22<sup>nd</sup> November at 10am

Round 8 22<sup>nd</sup> November at 3pm

Round 9 23<sup>rd</sup> November at 10am

- 8. . Placement of players is determined on the basis of points won. Additional criteria in case of division of places are:
  - 1. Buchholz criterion -1 (the weakest placed opponent is removed)
  - 2. Buchholz criterion
  - 3. Sonneborg-Berger system
  - 4. More victories

9. The organizer has planned a prize fund of 350,000 Serbian dinars, distributed in 10 regular prizes, as follows:

1st place 100,000 dinars

2nd place 70,000 dinars

3rd place 50,000 dinars

4th place 40,000 dinars

5th place 30,000 dinars

6th place 20,000 dinars

7th place 15,000 dinars

8th place 10,000 dinars

9th place 8,000 dinars

10th place 7,000 dinars

- 10. The competitor can win only one prize. In case of division of places, prizes will not be shared and the player with better ranking will win the prize.
- 11. All prize-winning players must be present at the closing ceremony which will take place 30 minutes after the end of the last game.
- 12. Mobile phones and other electronics are forbidden in playing area. The organizer has provided a designated spot for you to leave these items. Any player who violates this rule will forfeit the game.
- 13. To ensure the fairness of the competition and to show respect for all players, you must not forfeit a match by not showing up unless you've already notified the arbiter that you need to be excused from the pairing.
- 14. We'll fully enforce FIDE's anti-cheating measures throughout the tournament.
- 15. Lateness to the game is allowed up to 30 minutes. After 30 minutes, the player loses the game by default.
- 16. Radnicki Kovin Chess Club's official rules are prescribed by the Secretary. By making their first move, all players consent to these rules.
