

RULES

RADNICKICHESS TOURNAMENT Rating tournament - 2026

1. Chess Club Radnički, organized from 30.06. until 06.07. 2026, rating tournament.
2. The right to participate has the right to participate to all players who meet the requirements from the call and accepted by the tournament organizer.
3. The tournament is played according to the Berger system, 7 rounds, computer pairing (Swiss-Manager program).
4. The tempo of the game is 90 minutes. + 30 second bonus for every move. Writing moves is mandatory until the end of the game.
5. The tournament is played according to the valid FIDE Chess Rules for standard chess. The tournament is rated by FIDE.
6. Schedule and hourly rate for the start of the circuit:

7. The permitted delay of the player is 60 minutes, in relation to the scheduled start of the round.
8. Tournament director: Dragan Kotevski
9. Referee of the tournament: IA- Babić Dragan - chief referee
10. A competitor who loses a game by forfeiture (failure to attend the match) does not have the right to continue playing in the tournament without the approval of the tournament referee.
11. The judge's decision is enforceable and final.

12. The winner is the player who wins the most points. In case of division of places, the following criteria decide 1.- Sonneborn Berger (option 85) 2.- Mutual result (option 81) 3.- Which system (option 69) 4.- Greater number of victories (option 68) 5. Arrangement system (option 61). If everything is the same, a draw is used. The options used are from the pairing program.

13. The player is forbidden to have a mobile phone or any other electronic means of communication at the place of play.

14. Players who have finished the game are obliged to leave the playing area.

15. This Rulebook is prescribed by the tournament organizer, and by withdrawing his first move, the competitor gives his consent to this Rulebook and the obligation to comply with it.
