Presentation:** The Peão Cavalgante/Arneirense Association will organize the 5th International Chess Tournament of Caldas da Rainha/Peão Cavalgante Association Arneirense open to all players affiliated with the FPX or a foreign counterpart. For those who are not federated (affiliated with FPX) you can sign up, for example, with the Associação Peão Cavalgante/Arneirense, or another club.

1st Result between tied (11); 2nd Bucholz cutting the worst (37); 3rd total Bucholz (37);

4th FIDE Tie-Break (8); 5th Most wins (12);

If the number of participants recommends it, the organization can proceed with accelerated pairing in the first two days.

Each player will be entitled to use 1 "bye", except in the 4th and 5th Sessions, which will be awarded 0.5 points. To do this, the player must communicate his intention in writing to the competition management, by the end of the 1st session.
